Details of the field immersion trips undertaken by SCCE students in 2018-19

1. As part of the course - History and Historiography of Performance-II (HHP - II) SCC2PS103, a Field Immersion Trip was led by Benil Biswas to Anandpur Sahib during 19th March to 23rd March 2019. 15 students went on this trip.

the students visited Anandpur Sahib, one of the holiest Sikh sites, was founded by Guru Tegh Bahadur, during Hola Mohalla 2019. He lived in the Guru ka Mahal in the old quarter of the town. A museum dedicated to, and named after him, displays a collection of oil paintings depicting the trials and tribulations of his times. A shrine has also been raised in honour of Bhai Jaitha, who carried Guru Tegh Bahadur's head from Delhi to Punjab, after the Guru's execution. Takht Sri Kesgarh Sahib, the town's most sacred shrine, built on a hillock with the lower Shivaliks as a backdrop, is where Guru Gobind Singh formed the Khalsa Panth (Sikh Nation). It was in commemoration of the third centenary of the founding of the Panth, that the sprawling Khalsa Heritage Complex was envisaged and shaped into the state-of-the-art repository that we know it today. Called the Virasat-e-Khalsa. This museum sheds light on the vision of the Sikh Gurus, and provides an insight to Sikh history, culture and heritage.







As part of the course - Critical Perspectives on Creative Explorations (CPCE) SUS1 EL904, a Field Immersion Trip was led by Benil Biswas to Khajuraho during 25th Feb to 1st March 2019. There were 8 students.

The immersion took students to the Khajuraho Group of Monuments, one of the UNESCO World Heritage Sites in India. The temples are famous for their nagara-style architectural symbolism and sculptures. Students also experienced the annual Khajuraho Dance Festival 2019, which happens in the last week of February, near the Western Group of Temples at Khajuraho. Besides the guided tour of the archaeological sites, students visited the Adivart Tribal and Folk Art Museum, housing the rich collection of tribal and folk art and artefacts. The museum also offers a brief history of custom and rituals of the tribal people of Madhya Pradesh. There was also an immersion into Nature, with a short visit to Raney Falls. The immersion yields in a field journal and a critically reflective essay for the students.
