

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

Issues Discussed and the decisions taken:

1. Election of Representatives

As decided amongst the participating members through discussions on Watsapp group, one of the main agendas of this meeting was to elect the representatives for the association. Only Shamshad, Rashmi and Laxmi had put forth their names for the post of President, Vice-President and Treasurer. In the absence of any other nomination, all the members present accepted these three as elected for the respective positions. Additionally, it was decided that Bhawna (with assistance from Priyanka and Pragya) will act as the internal coordinator amongst members to keep track of the work that will be handed to different members.

2. Work related to Registration of association

3. Measures to ensure better participation

It was felt that there is a general lack of interest and very less participation from the students of the two batches who have passed out from SES so far and are being looked at as the first set of members. The group discussed ways to secure maximum participation by all. For this purpose, it was decided that an online survey can be conducted to reach out to all prospective members and obtain their views on this association and in what manner would they like to associate with and contribute to the association. What are the ways in which association can help them.

4. Date for Annual Day meeting

After deliberation on several possible dates, the members present decided to keep 2nd Saturday in the month of January as the date for the Annual Meeting of the members of the association. This date was chosen keeping in view the weather conditions, the festival timings where many will be occupied as well as the nature of work different members are engaged in at the moment and the time of the year when the most of them will be able to join.

5. Activities to be commenced by the association in near future:

The members decided upon a few things that can be done this year:

a. A seminar can be organized in a few months time (Sep/Oct/Nov) in which the entry will be open to all the graduates of SES and the recent graduates of education departments of other universities as well.

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b. To decide upon the topic of the Seminar, it was suggested that the SES members can start a web page/blog where any of the members can write/share his/her views on any topic related to education that interests him/her. Then, over a period of time, judging by the bent and inclination of most members, a number of topics can be shortlisted for the seminar.

c. To decide upon the topic of Seminar and then plan for the same, the group will have to meet again. For this, the date will be discussed over the email and wattsapp groups.

d. The group also discussed about creation of an editorial board for selecting the papers to be presented at seminar. Rima and Rashmi expressed their wish to be on this editorial board. A few more members from the present and the now graduating batch can also help in this task. Apart from the student members of the association, somebody from the faculty of SES can be nominated to help out in the process. In addition to this, the group strongly felt the need to include an external member (who has not been associated with SES, AUD either as faculty or student) in order to ensure impartiality. For this, members can suggest names of suitable persons they know from other institutions. The association will approach the persons whose names are shortlisted out of the suggested names.

e. The association will need to procure an ISBN no. to publish the papers presented through seminar and otherwise. SES faculty will help in procuring the same. One or two student members will carry out the communication with them in this regard and help wherever needed.

6. Collection of funds and initial fee:

In the first meeting, after considering several factors like the need of funds for the activities of the association, securing maximum membership, economic capacity of different members, etc., the members had decided to keep Rs. 500 as the membership fee for the time being, at least for the first two batches that had graduated by that time. It was also decided that membership fee for the subsequent batches could be raised if the group wished to do so. An annual membership renewal fee was also suggested, but no decision on that was taken.

In this meeting, the group decided to keep the membership fee the same for the batch of students passing out this year. The members agreed upon depositing the amount so collected in association's bank account (to be opened). Since this amount is less, it will not be used for any activity organized by the association for at least a few years and will be used as an investment in some appropriate bank schemes in order to generate more funds.

Therefore, while planning for any future activity, members will have to contribute additional funds as per requirement of the event. Members can also voluntarily contribute funds as per their capacity once the bank account has been opened. Other sources of funding can be explored depending on the nature of the activity. E.g. for the seminar, a registration fee can be levied on graduates of other universities who register to present their papers.

Keeping in mind, the scarcity of resources at the moment, the group will organize its initial events in the AUD Campus only so that costs can be minimized.

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7. Orientation meeting for the students of SES graduating this year

The representatives of the association (Shamshad, Laxmi and Rashmi) will organize a meeting with the graduating students of SES and orient them about SES Alumni-Alumnae Association, its purpose, vision and the activities being planned in the near future. They will also collect membership fee from the students who are willing to be members. The representatives will report about this meeting to the other members through an appropriate channel and also share the views/suggestions shared by the graduating students/new members. With this last decision, the members concluded their meeting.

As the second cohort graduates in 2015, the School is proposing to activate a formal mechanism that facilitates linking/networking its graduates, tracing the professional trajectories that the graduates have charted, and nurturing of a shared institutional identity.

Objectives of the Alumni/Alumnae Association

- To network the different cohorts of graduates of the School. The alumni association, in due course, may help in tracing SES graduates, sharing placement related information and networks, and publicizing the programmes and endeavours of the School.
- 2. To offer a formal space for the graduates of the School, who would have assumed various career trajectories, to come together and share their professional experiences and think around issues that relate to the field of education.
- To collectively shape an institutional culture characterised by humanism, collegiality, teamwork and creativity – which is drawn from the vision of AUD of bridging equality and social justice with excellence.

Proposed Structure

The membership to the Association is open for the SES graduates only. The SES faculty will play only an advisory role in the Association. The faculty will nominate a Faculty Advisor for the Association each year. [Dr. Gunjan Sharma and Mr. Akha Kaihrii Mao are anchoring the launch of the Association]. Non-Alumni/Alumnae faculty members would not be able to contest on any representative positions in the Association.

Membership Fee

There are two kinds of fee with which the Association will carry out its functions:

- 1. A one-time life membership fee of Rs. 500
- 2. A recurrent annual fee (to be decided by the Association)
